THIRD ANNUAL TAZÓN DE ESTRELLAS TO BE BROADCAST LIVE ON TVC DEPORTES IN MEXICO AND INTERNATIONALLY THROUGH A WEBCAST ON GLOBALFOOTBALL.COM

THURSDAY, DECEMBER 8, 2011 – GRANBURY, TEXAS – The third annual Tazón de Estrellas (Bowl of the Stars) will be broadcast live on television in Mexico and will air internationally via a live webcast on www.GlobalFootball.com on Saturday, December 17.

Viewers will be able to watch Team Stars & Stripes, selected from 28 NCAA Division III colleges in the United States, take on the CONADEIP All-Stars from Mexico at the 5,000-seat El Templo del Dolor (The Temple of Pain) in Puebla, kickoff 1.30pm on December 17.

The live webcast will carry the TVC Deportes television feed that will be broadcast in Mexico. Viewers from other countries will be directed from the GlobalFootball.com website to the Universidad de las Americas Puebla website, where the live stream is available in both English and Spanish. Viewers should use Windows Media Player 9 for the best results.

Players from the following 28 colleges will be represented on the Team Stars & Stripes roster: Amherst College (2), Augustana (4), California Lutheran University (1), Capital University (1) Castleton State (1), Central (6), Centre College (1), Claremont-Mudd-Scripts Colleges (2), Cornell College (1), Dickinson College (1), Fitchburg State University (1), Grinnell (2), Grove City College (1), Hanover College (2), John Carroll University (2), Loras (2), Ohio Northern University (2), Rockford College (1), Rose-Hulman Institute (1), Simpson College (5), St. Vincent College (4), Susquehanna University (1), Thomas More College (2), Trinity University (1), UW/Stevens Point (2), Wartburg College (2), Willamette University (1) and Wooster (1).

The CONADEIP All-Stars are a select group of student-athletes from ten Mexican institutions of higher learning: UDLAP (20 players), ITESM Monterrey (19), ITESM Estado de México (11), ITESM Toluca (5), ITESM CCM (2), ITESM CSF (2), UR (2), ITESM Puebla (1), ITP (1) and UAMN (1).

The Tazón de Estrellas and its forerunner the Aztec Bowl have produced a series of exciting games and established a fierce but friendly rivalry between the American team drawn from D-III all-stars and their counterparts selected from the CONADEIP national conference of private schools in Mexico. Last year Team Stars and Stripes triumphed 48-7 in Toluca, having suffered a 24-12 loss to the Tec Monterrey All-Stars in the first Tazón de Estrellas in 2009.
