EVENT OVERVIEW

April 9-17, 2011

HISTORY: In 2007 and 2008 a select group of high school seniors representing numerous states and dozens of high schools traveled to Kawasaki, a Tokyo suburb, to play the Japanese U19 National Team, while enjoying the hospitality and culture of the Japanese people. In 2010 a similar team traveled to and played in France. This experience proved to be a very special week, and so now we are thrilled to offer another unique opportunity for honored student athletes, going to Germany in April 2011!

2011 EVENT: Germany boasts the most American football teams and players in Europe, through its junior coaches in Bavaria, has invited Global Football to select and bring a *Team Stars & Stripes* to Munich to play against an all-star team of select players ages 19 and under. We are proud to provide this opportunity to a very select group of US high school seniors who represent the very best student athletes of America.

TEAMS: National teams of 44 players representing Germany and the United States. All players will be age 19 and under, whose coaches have nominated their student athletes due to their athletic and academic success, as well as their personal character.
