Dear Team Stars & Stripes Family, Friend and Coach:

It is a high honor that your son/player has been selected to travel with us and play in the Bowl of Stars. Global Football, together with the top private university league of Mexico - CONADEIP, are excited to manage this game for the 18th year. I look forward to working with your son/player in Mexico. We are committed to doing everything possible to make this a safe, dynamic and historic week for him!

Over the years we have provided over 800 senior NCAA Division III players this unique opportunity. The prospect of completing their college careers while training and playing alongside some of the very best D3 players is an experience they will not soon forget. Playing American football against a very talented and motivated Mexican all-star team will present your son one more test of his abilities. Like no other all-star game, this 8 day trip is on an international stage and exclusive to NCAA Division III players. While we have won all but 4 of the games, we lost last year when we played in Puebla. This is a real game with no special all-star game rules. Many games have come down to the final possession.

You have supported your son/player for many years, traveling to many different stadiums to watch him play. Now you have one more chance, this time in Baja, Mexico. It is located southwest of San Diego. We would like to invite you to come join us there, for however many days you feel you can spare. While we would like to assist you in any way possible, it is simply not logistically feasible for us to book your flights and hotel. The Global Football staff will focus primarily on taking care of Team Stars and Stripes. However, based on many years of experience, we can offer some options that should help make your trip comfortable.

Flights/Transfer – Make your own reservation. We suggest you arrive no earlier than Wednesday the 16th and leave Sunday, December 20th. San Diego has a full-service airport, handling many direct flights from the states on a daily basis. The airport is about 90 minutes from the recommended team hotel.
